Financial aid regula ons assume that the family has primary responsibility for mee ng the educa onal costs of students. If you are considered a dependent student according to the financial aid defini on, your aid eligibility is determined by using parent income and asset informa on in addi on to your informa on. Dependent students are required by law to provide parental informa on and signatures to be considered for financial aid.

Occasionally, due to unusual circumstances, students should not be considered as dependent. If you can document why you should be considered independent for some unusual reason, you may pe on for a waiver of federal regula ons requiring parental acceptance. The U. S. Department of Education and the four pendency override. Those circumstances are:

1. Parents refusing to contribute to the student's educa on; 2. Parents unwilling to provide informa on on the applica on or for verifica on; 3. Parents notrition after verition of the student's education on the application of the student's education of the studen
