HIGHLIGHTED FEATURES/FIXES

<p>Submission receipts Students can receive a notification email for each assignment attempt with information about the submission including attached files. Students can also access receipts at any time on the My Grades page in the submissions filter area. Administrators can optionally disable the email notifications.</p>
<p>Videos in Assignment Submissions: When students submit assignments and add embedded video using the Mashups or the “My YouTube” button, it can be viewed within the Content Editor prior to submission.</p>
<p>Additional Drag-and-Drop Locations. The drag-and-drop feature has been added to the Content Collection, Content Editor, Blank Page, Blogs, Journals, and Portfolios. If the browser allows, users can drag a folder of files and the files will upload individually.</p>
<p>Content Collection Improvements: The Content Collection has been improved to remove spam vulnerabilities and enhance search indexing performance. These improvements were also included in prior-version maintenance releases.</p>
<p>SIS Integration Changes: New REST web services have been added to retrieve job status and record processing errors. Administrators can implement real-time monitoring and issue resolution processes. Command-line snapshot tools have been removed. Flat, snapshot-formatted files can still be processed through the SIS Integration Framework.</p>

Mobile Improvements: The discussion board is responsive for mobile devices if the post contents are responsive. Discussion participants can read, respond, and use other discussion features such as post rating.
